



That Day. The Great Day.



- The Day of the Lord is judgment associated with Messiah's Second Coming.
- The Day of the Lord is a time when God's judgement will come upon the nations and Israel.





"The great day of the LORD is near... A day of wrath is that day, a day of distress and anguish, a day of ruin and devastation, a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and thick darkness, a day of trumpet blast and battle cry."

- Zephaniah 1:14-16

"Behold, a day is coming for the LORD... On that day his feet shall stand on the Mount of Olives... And on that day a great panic from the LORD shall fall upon them."

- Zechariah 14



Joel

- Joel, one of the *earlier prophets*, mentions **Day of the Lord** 5x (most)
- "Locusts" *now* (1:1-20) *then* (2:1-17)
- Deuteronomy 28

Amos

- Amos was from Judah (south), but his message was for Israel (north).
- Amos was a shepherd (1:1).
- Amos spoke into Israel *prosperity* (Jeroboam II).


