






The Olivet Discourse

"As he sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him, privately, saying, 'Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign of your coming and the end of the age?"



### The Olivet Discourse

- Delivered in the final days of his ministry, just prior to his crucifixion (Mark 14:1).
- Given subsequent to 'woes' on Jewish leaders (Matthew 23).
- One of two major, extended discourses in life of Christ, as recorded in the gospels.



"Jesus left the temple and was going away, when his disciples came to point out to him the buildings of the temple. But he answered them, You see all these, do you not? Truly, I say to you, there will not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down."

Matthew 24:1-2

### AD 70

### Destruction of the Temple

Roman Commander Titus surrounded the city on April 9.

Supplies cut-off, people trapped in the city, gradually starving city inhabitants.

Final overthrow occurred in September. Temple destroyed.






